



Beachlands School Device Expectations

As a responsible user of devices we all need to follow the schoolwide expectations:

- Devices are a learning tool and will only be used to complete learning tasks set by the teacher.
- School email addresses are only to be used for sharing learning and anything that requires 'signing up' must be approved by the teacher.
- All devices are to be used while sitting at a table to ensure good posture and transparency of what is on the screen.
- All devices must be handled with care and when being carried they are to be held by the base not the screen.
- Devices are only to be used under teacher supervision, during class time.
- Devices need to be stored in the appropriate box / cupboard and stacked sideways rather than piled on top of one another.
- IT monitors are the only students responsible for and handling the devices going in and out of the smartboxes.
- Classroom devices need to be shared and 'signed out' of after each use.
- Any damages and problems need to be reported to the teacher.

As these are our agreed upon schoolwide expectations for using devices at school if a breach of these expectations occur it may result in losing access to school ICT services. This includes the use of the internet, on school owned devices or any personally owned device used at school for a minimum period of two weeks.
