

We need parent help for this event to take place – helpers required at 4.00pm for set up and then throughout the disco.



Shopping Online At Beachlands School


We've set up our Kindo online school shop to make it easy for our families to pay for school costs anywhere, anytime. It's open 24/7, and available on our school website. Now you've set-up your family account, have funds available, and it's time to make a payment.



Your family accounts

The Fees and Donations Service will show you what currently owes on your family account.

You will see the Original cost, what has already been paid, and the current outstanding amount for each item.



You can choose to pay the full amount by clicking on the  next to the item.

Some items will allow you to change the amount (making a part payment) before clicking the button. 

Once you've finished selecting your items and payments you can select to complete your transaction.




Optional payments

Other optional payment icons will also appear on our School shop.

Click the initial for the student requiring the item.

The item will bold and display the quantity that has been added to your cart.



When you have finished selecting the items for your child's order click

If there are sufficient funds in your account, you will be able to simply click 'Place order'.

If there are insufficient funds you will be required to Top-up your account before placing the order.

Your order and payment will automatically go through to the school, and you will receive an electronic receipt confirming your payment or top-up.
