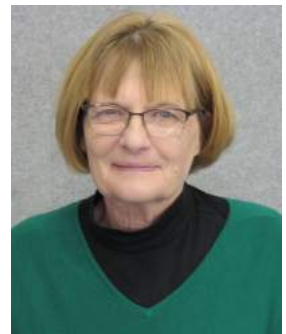
Welcome to the Beachlands School Team, Mrs Tina Brown

The children that helped make the relish were able to take one home to share with their whanau, a jar was given to have at our farewell morning tea for Mr Nobel-Campbell while the remaining jars will be distributed within our community via the Takutai Trust Food Bank.

More beetroot has been planted and the children look forward to finding other ways to use the produce they produce.
