## Our Kokako Mural commissioned by Rotary

Last week we were privileged to officially unveil our beautiful new mural of a Kokako which was painted by local artist Sandra Russell and donated to our school by the Pohutukawa Coast Rotary.

We were delighted to have Sandra join us on the day alongside John Stacey from Rotary, Lenny from Predator Free Franklin and students from our Rimu Team. One of Rotary's goals is promoting the need to protect the environment and our students were told about the trapping



and pest eradication projects that have allowed the Kokako to thrive within the Hunua ranges.

The Kokako painting has a cultural significance in connecting Beachlands school students as Kaitiaki to their community's heritage, with what was once an almost extinct endemic native species in the Hunua ranges (a native forest that borders the Beachlands, Maraetai, Clevedon areas) their number are now flourishing. There is a local community link with an addition to the painting of an oddly shaped tree which can be found within the Omana Regional Park which many of the children have already found within the painting and can be connected to.

We would like to thank Mr Trevor Law, Caretaker and our school gardener, Nicola Raye, who worked very hard to ensure this beautiful mural is displayed for our school to enjoy. The EFS team led by Mrs Rebecca Skeen and Miss Natalie Pallesen continues to work with our students to uphold the values of kaitiakitanga and as a Green-Gold Enviro school we are constantly looking for ways we can both enhance and preserve our environment


