Years 5-8 School Police Presentation



Last Tuesday, Beachlands School senior classes were visited by Police Constable Pauline Orpet and Matthew Green, who serve as School Community Officers.

They spoke to our students about the importance of safety, both online and offline, and emphasised that everyone has the right to feel safe in their environment. The session provided valuable insights on how to ask for help in difficult situations and offered practical strategies for coping with bullying.

During the visit, students engaged in roleplays and discussed real-life scenarios, helping them to better understand how to respond to challenging social situations. The discussion also covered the potential dangers of social media, empowering students with the knowledge to navigate these platforms responsibly. The session was a great opportunity for students to learn about personal safety, community support, and building positive relationships.

Well done to the team and thank you to the commitment of the coaches and parents who supported this wonderful team.


SEZ Touch Rugby - Are you a touch ref and can help us?
