Self Regulation Approaches



At school we use several approaches to help children manage their emotions/frustrations. Like at home, when children can get frustrated, they can say and choose actions that are outside of our FERN values and schools expectations for behaviour.

All classrooms are leading mindful breathing each day. This is a great way to calm the body and reset. There are many mindful exercises located on the internet. Perhaps families could put aside one mindful breathing exercise together each day.

Choices - I Always Have a Choice

We are regularly reinforcing to all children that they have a choice when they get frustrated. When children feel frustrated, we refer to the four quadrants below.



- 1. Calm Breathing
- 2. Tell the person/people who are frustrating you to stop in a calm way
- 3. Walk away and find a teacher/staff member who will help figure out the frustrations and find a resolution
- 4. Go to a thinking, calm, safe place to allow your mind and body to settle

Parents, please talk with your children about using these strategies when they are feeling frustrated either at school or perhaps try them at home if appropriate.

If you have a school office query, please phone or email the school office, rather than coming into the school office.


Please help us minimise the spread of COVID and keep all our students and staff safe. Thank you for your support with this.
